Requirements & Payment Schedule

Each of the undergraduate scholarships (except for the Veta Watson Percy) is paid in two installments (Fall and Spring). The following qualifications apply to all these scholarships.

- 1. Applicants **must** have a 3.0 GPA on all college work completed *or* a total of 1000 on the SAT or 24 in English on the ACT for entering freshmen (The Robert and Marjorie Hirsch scholarship requires a minimum GPA of 2.5)
- 2. The continuation of all scholarships into the second semester is contingent upon maintaining a **GPA of 3.0 in at least 12 semester hours of course work** (15 for the Mohat) and making at least a grade of B in each English class.
- 3. The student must be enrolled at UNT, but does not have to be a Texas resident.

Transcripts (unofficial accepted for current students)

Freshman applicants only: proof of SAT or ACT scores

Cover letter describing any honors and activities (both academic and nonacademic) that show your high level of responsibility and commitment to literary studies and / or writing. Letter should include specific examples.

Whitten applicants only: proof of native Texas residency, such as a birth certificate

Sampley applicants only: one piece of creative writing

Haydar applicants only: three poems
