## Requirements & Payment Schedule

Each of the undergraduate scholarships (except for the Veta Watson Percy) is paid in two installments (Fall and Spring). The following qualifications apply to all these scholarships.

- Applicants must have a 3.0 GPA on all college work completed or a total of 1000 on the SAT or 24 in English on the ACT for entering freshmen (The Robert and Marjorie Hirsch scholarship requires a minimum GPA of 2.5)
- The continuation of all scholarships into the second semester is contingent upon maintaining a GPA of 3.0 in at least 12 semester hours of course work (15 for the Mohat) and making at least a grade of B in each English class.
- The student must be enrolled at UNT, but does not have to be a Texas resident.
